<p>EDUCATION VISIT TERMS AND CONDITIONS Please read the following and then sign and return. By doing so you agree to all terms and conditions.</p>		
<p>1. Whilst staff and volunteers will take all reasonable care, and work within clear health and safety and child protection guidelines, <i>the responsibility for the care, safety and discipline of the children remains with the school at all times.</i> A teacher who organises a visit to Mount Zion (hereafter referred to as the organiser) must appoint an additional responsible adult to accompany each working group (usually children work in two groups).</p> <p>2. Whilst Mount Zion has its own health and safety policy, public liability Insurance and has carried out its own risk assessment, the organiser is responsible for their own risk assessment for the visit. If you would like to book a preliminary visit to facilitate you in carrying out an assessment, the Heritage Worker will provide assistance in you so doing.</p> <p>3. <i>The organiser is responsible for the management and discipline of the children throughout the visit</i> and must ensure that they understand the need for respectful behaviour in a place of worship.</p> <p>4.
