Please read the following and then sign and return. By doing so you agree to all terms and conditions.

1. Whilst staff and volunteers will take all reasonable care, and work within clear health and safety and child protection guidelines, ***the responsibility for the care, safety and discipline of the children remains with the school at all times.*** A teacher who organises a visit to Mount Zion (hereafter referred to as the organiser) must appoint an additional responsible adult to accompany each working group (usually children work in two groups).

2.
